This time there were, special summer camps organized at Saibangoda village, a tribal hamlet in which 118 tribal children participated.

The activities were taken as such Theater, Fun with Science, Fun with Math's, Water Conservation, Recycling and Waste Management, Puppet Making, Mask Making, Day Time Astronomy, Snake Shows, Magic, Sports, Origami, Paper Making, Nature Trail, Warli Painting, Calligraphy, Film Screening. Dance and Music.

The duration of summer camp was for a week. Children were provided materials, snacks and lunch free of cost.


